## Advantages for Business

- Unlike many rural counties, Nelson County residents and businesses have access to a 31 mile high-speed fiber optic network. This network runs through the center of the County, offering high-speed internet to many businesses and to the Colleen Business Park, bringing the benefits of advanced information technology infrastructure to Nelson County's idyllic and pastoral setting.
- Nelson County boasts direct access to I-64 and is a 15 minute drive from I-81. The county sits less than 40 miles from both the Charlottesville Albemarle Airport and the Lynchburg Regional Airport.
- Several major universities and two-year institutions, including the top-ranked University of Virginia, and Piedmont Virginia Community College are within an hour's drive.
