KURT J. KRUEGER RECEIVES PRESTIGIOUS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AWARD

CHARLOTTESVILLE, VIRGINIA —The Central Virginia Partnership for Economic Development (Partnership) is pleased to announce that Kurt J. Krueger was awarded the Leigh B. Middleditch, Jr. Award for Excellence in Economic Development at the Partnership’s 25th Anniversary Annual Meeting today. The award, only given in exceptional circumstances, recognizes an outstanding leader who has provided extraordinary support to regional economic development and has done so with integrity, tenacity, and a philanthropic spirit. John Young, Chairman of the Board and Regional President of Atlantic Union Bank, and Leigh Middleditch presented the award.

The award has only been awarded twice – first to Mr. Middleditch in 2014 and second to Charles Rotgin, Jr., founder of Great Eastern Management Company, in 2016. It is named in honor of Mr. Middleditch, a founding Board member of the Partnership and a leader in promoting regional economic development.

Mr. Young shared that “Kurt is a selfless individual who has led by example to inspire others and has taken a proactive role in regional economic development.” In addition to serving as counsel to the Partnership almost since the organization’s inception twenty-five years ago, Mr. Krueger served as its Chairman in FY 2019. A graduate of University of Virginia (BA and JD), Mr. Krueger has had an impressive legal career at McGuireWoods and has practiced at the firm’s Charlottesville office for over 35 years. Mr. Young added that “Kurt’s tireless contributions to the Partnership and commitment to regional economic development are greatly appreciated.”
