- High educational attainment: 39% of the population has earned a Bachelor's degree or higher.
- Piedmont Virginia Community College and Germanna Community College are actively engaged in workforce development, providing courses and training for in-demand career tracks and partnering with businesses to customize programs.
- The business school incubator at the University of Virginia's Darden School of Business, known as the i.Lab, serves entrepreneurs and start-ups from any of UVA's 12 schools or from the region. The Charlottesville Metropolitan Statistical Area was named the fastest growing venture capital ecosystem in the United States by the National Venture Capital Association in 2016. Six of the top nine startups in Charlottesville used i.Lab resources.
