A robust and growing defense and security sector in the region is in part due to the region's proximity to Washington, D.C. and to the significant presence of the U.S. Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) and the National Ground Intelligence Center (NGIC) at Rivanna Station.

- For more than half a century, the **National Ground Intelligence Center** has had a significant presence in the area and employs more than 1,400 service members and civilians. Also housed at Rivanna Station, the **Defense Intelligence Agency** employs over 850 people.
- **UVA Research Park** is located just a mile from Rivanna Station and has become home to many intelligence-gathering government contractors such as Battelle, MITRE, CACI, and SRC.
- **Aerojet Rocketdyne** is a world-recognized aerospace and defense leader, providing propulsion and energetics to its space, missile defense, tactical missile, and armaments customers throughout the world.
- Serving the defense aerial, ground-based, and naval markets, **EURO-COMPOSITES** is the general supplier of KEVLAR honeycomb for the Joint Strike Fighter (F-35) of Lockheed Martin.

- Proximity to national defense industry centered in Washington, D.C.

- Robust, redundant fiber optics network; multiple telecommunications networks and electrical power providers including CenturyLink, Dominion Energy, Rappahannock Electric Cooperative, and Central Virginia Electric Cooperative.
- Access to world-class University of Virginia faculty and research including the UVA Research Park – a 562-acre, fully master planned, mixed-use development zoned for up to 3.7 million square feet of development. The Park houses the Applied Research Institute, which leverages the University's human and capital assets to support applied research, education and training with a focus on homeland security, national intelligence and defense challenges.
- Composite cost of living is 36% lower in Central Virginia than Northern Virginia/Washington, D.C. region.
