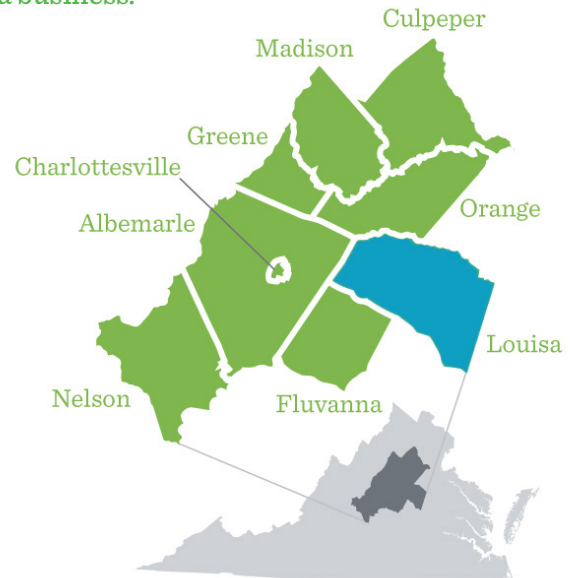

Advantages for Business

- Increasingly, the business community is finding Louisa to be an attractive central location for commercial investment.
- Interstate 64 forms the backbone of Louisa County, providing 20 miles of interstate with four interchanges along the way. The County is located halfway between Interstates 95 and 81, both major north/south transportation corridors.
- 50% percent of the nation's consumers are within one day delivery by truck making Louisa the perfect location for manufacturing and distribution operations.
- Louisa County is only a 30 minute drive from the Charlottesville/Albemarle Regional Airport and a 1 hour drive from the Richmond International Airport.
- Several major universities and two-year institutions are within an hour's drive, including the top-ranked University of Virginia, Virginia Commonwealth University, University of Richmond, Virginia State, Virginia Union, Mary Washington, Longwood, Randolph Macon, Piedmont Virginia Community College, and Germanna Community College.
